Your time and efforts will be well spent collecting items and delivering them to those in need at the new Mooresville Kindness Closet at HealthReach in Downtown Mooresville. We have created this toolkit to help you get the most out of this meaningful community service opportunity.

ABOUT THE KINDNESS CLOSET

The Mooresville Kindness Closet (MKC) was founded in 2018 and is committed to addressing hygiene poverty. Hygiene poverty is the inability to afford basic household and hygiene items that are not covered by government assistance such as deodorant, soap, feminine products, toilet paper, toothpaste and shampoo and laundry detergent. Food banks and other services in the area do not have a consistent supply of basic household goods, so the MKC's mission complements services already serving low-income populations. Additionally, the MKC is committed to fostering community service and engagement by having local groups and families assist with the gathering and distribution of the donations.

ABOUT THE CLOSET AT HEALTHREACH

The Mooresville Kindness Closet is excited to launch a new closet inside HealthReach Community Clinic for HealthReach's patients. HealthReach is the only free clinic in Iredell County and serves 800+ patients a year. This partnership allows Mooresville Kindness Closet to reach a population susceptible to hygiene poverty and also allows HealthReach to further its mission of wellness for its patients. This is a true win-win.

STEPS TO SPONSORING THE CLOSET

Choose a week that works best with your schedule to bring donations to HealthReach. Sign up on the Sign-Up Genius to secure your week slot to drop off at HealthReach office.

Start a supply drive or purchase the specific items listed on the following pages. Most items have a needed quantity of 10 per week. As space is limited, please supply only these items.

You should plan on delivering items on Tuesday - which is the day they are open the latest.

Calling during business hours 704-663-1992 is the best method of arranging a time to stock the Kindness Closet. They are open late Tuesdays.

[Where is the best place to purchase items for the Kindness Closet?](#)

Shampoo and conditioner, deodorant, toothbrushes, mouthwash, toothpaste, dish soap, laundry detergent, lotion and brushes are least expensive at the dollar stores. They have a dollar section which offers quality name brands for \$1.

Costco, Sam's Club, BJ's Target or Walmart are least expensive for paper goods and Clorox wipes.

[Once I've acquired all of the products, what is the easiest way to transport them into HealthReach?](#)

In order to cause the least disruption to the operations at HealthReach, please load all of the products into a couple shopping bags and bring them in quietly. Please be careful not to block the pathway for patients entering the treatment area. Wearing a mask is required in this clinic.
